  - Rotating exhibits
  - Meeting/conference space

  - Nine-foot Mike Larsen statue depicts Chickasaws' arrival in Indian Territory
- 15 Aba' Aanowa' Sky Bridge**
  - Overlooks the Village
- 16 Chikasha Inchokka' Traditional Village**
  - Historically accurate replica of a Homeland Chickasaw village
- 17 Inkana' Bridge**
  - Connects to Chickasaw National Recreation Area
